 (g) Battles:

1 January 1945: Security patrolling continued throughout the night and at first light the situation was reported to be quiet. At 1130 hrs, word was received that all troops west of the north-south road leading through Terwagne, would move east of that road, also the 330th Inf (- 2 Bns) of the 83d Division

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was attached and would have to be billeted in our area. Arrangements were made to move elements of Hogan and Orr, who were west of the new boundary line. The billeting parties of the 335th Inf. (-2d and 3d Bns) arrived and were assigned an area. By 2100 hrs, the 350th Inf. (-2d and 3d Bns) had closed. Security patrolling continued after the hours of darkness. At 1745 hrs, FO No 20, 3d Armd Div, was received and reconnaissance was made for a move to the southwest.

1st Bn, 36th AIR was attached to CC R and was assembled in the Terwagne area. All companies were under bn control. 2d Bn, 36th AIR was attached to CC B, and was assembled at Les Avins, Belgium. 3d Bn, 36th AIR was attached to CC A and was assembled in the vicinity of Warzee. All companies were under bn control.

2 January. Patrolling continued throughout the night and at first light, all was reported quiet. At 0630 hrs, billeting parties left for the new area and at 1230 hrs, movement to the new area commenced. The entire day was consumed in moving the Combat Command, due to traffic congestion on the roads. The last unit, 23d Engr Bn, reported closed in the area at 2320 hrs. The entire Combat Command was concentrated in the area around Perrières at this time.

The 2d Bn was located north of Vaux Chevonne and Grand Menil. The Bn moved to an assembly area behind the 33d Infantry Division and was not in contact with the enemy. Plans were made to attack with 1st Bn, 33d Armd Regt, at daylight, 3 January. The 3d Bn moved from Warzee to Habiemont, Belgium and had one company attached to Task Force K. The remainder of the Bn was in Task Force L.

3 January 1945. The situation remained quiet throughout the night and at 1215 hrs the 1dv CP moved to the vicinity of Verboisont. At 1505 hrs, TF Hogan was formed and alerted for movement. Movement started and at 2215 hrs, TF Hogan had closed in the Au Hêtre area. TF Hogan now consisted of the following troops: 3d Bn, 33d Armd Regt; 1st Bn, 335th Inf; 1 platoon Co B, 23d Engr Bn and 1 platoon Co B 703d TD Bn. At 2035 hrs, verbal orders were received from Div to move TF Lane at 0700 hrs, 4 Jan to the vicinity of Bergifan. The Inf attached to this task force (1st Bn, 36th AIR) was to seize the nose at 606922 and hold it until the passage of CC A to the south, at which time TF Lane was to reassemble in a new area. Col Lane and Col Orr were called to the CP and were issued orders for the operation. Composition of TF Lane at this time was as follows: 1st Bn, 32d Armd Regt; 1st Bn, 36th AIR; 1 platoon Co B, 23d Engr Bn and 1 platoon Co B, 703d TD Bn.

The 2d Bn was located 1000 yds southeast of Vaux Chevonne. The Bn attack was held up by a road block, small arms and mortar fire and they waited there for the night. The 3d Bn had no change in attachments. The Bn was located south of Floret, Belgium and Co I had captured Floret. Co I was with TF I and advanced to (602918).

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4 January 1945. No activity was reported during the night. At 0700 hrs, 2d Lms moved out as scheduled and at 0900 hrs, the 1st Bn, 36th AIR, reported that the operation had started. At 1030 hrs, the 1st Bn, 36th AIR, had advanced 500 yds, encountering no opposition and at 1140 hrs, was on the objective. The 1st Bn, 33d Armd Regt closed into Bergifaz at 1200 hrs and was ordered to remain there. The 1st Bn, 36th AIR, was ordered to continue to hold its objective and at 1420 hrs, information was received that a Bn of the 35th Inf would relieve the 1st Bn, 36th AIR, of the responsibility of its objective. Upon relief, the 1st Bn, 36th AIR, would assemble at Bergifaz. At 1420 hrs, orders were received to move IP Hogan to the vicinity of Munhay to attack at 0800 hrs, 5 January, to capture the cross-road at 576853. Movement began at 1515 hrs and at 1640 hrs, IP Hogan had closed in his assembly area. The relief of the 1st Bn, 36th AIR, was completed at 1905 hrs and it closed in its designated assembly area at 2040 hrs.

The 3d Bn captured Bonneux. Co D led the attack and cleared the town of the enemy and outposted the town for the night. The Bn advanced approximately 2 miles. Capt Smith took command from Maj Founse who had been evacuated. Co E of the 3d Bn, 36th AIR, held point 585925 and Co G, with 1 medium Tank Plt, captured ford and bridge at 611910.

5 January 1945. After a patrol from the 1st Bn, 330th Infantry had moved to Malampré and had encountered no opposition, Col Hogan moved Cos A and B of the 330th Inf and Co G of the 33d Armd Regt to that town. This force closed into the area at 0300 hrs. Co H, 33d Armd Regt, with Co G, 330th Inf, moved to the woods at 544881. At 0800 hrs, the left force (Co G, 33d and Cos A and B, 330th) attacked from Malampré and encountered a road block at 566876. The block consisted of mines and was covered by anti-tank fire. Since it was impossible to move around the block with the tanks, Cos A and B, 330th Inf, continued toward the objective. At 1400 hrs, the right force (Co H, 33d and Co G, 330th) jumped off from their assembly area at 544881 and attacked down the main road leading to the objective. This force ran into a block composed of a knocked out enemy tank at 558866. Cos A and B, 330th Inf had reached Croix St Jacques at this time. Co G, 33d Armd Regt, was moved back to Malampré and into the woods (544881) previously vacated by Co H, 33d Armd Regt. The right force sent out a patrol at 2315 hrs in an attempt to move across the open ground at 558864. They were pinned down by an enemy road block at 563862.

Co E and Co F, 2d Bn, 36th Armd Inf Regt, advanced 1000 yds southeast of Bonneux and were held up in the woods by enemy delaying action. Co D remained in Bonneux with 1st Bn, 33d. Capt Metcalfe took command from Capt Smith, who was wounded in action. Co E outposted the woods during the night. The 3d Bn was located north of La Voux and Co H captured the main part of La Voux. At 2000 hrs, orders were received from Division to have the 3d Bn, 36th AIR (Co A) replaced by 1st Bn, 36th AIR. The 1st Bn, 36th AIR would pass through the 3d Bn, 36th AIR, thereby relieving it. The 3d Bn, 36th AIR, would then revert to CG E.

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6 January 1945. At 0800 hrs, Col Hogan's right force jumped off for the objective and at 0930 hrs were reported at 563862. At 1040 hrs, it was reported that the right and left forces had made contact at 567860. At 1240 hrs, Hogan's right column was blocked by fallen trees across the road and three tanks and one TD had been knocked out by enemy tank fire. Cos A and B (left force) continued to attack and by 2240 hrs were reported on high ground 200 yds northeast of the objective. Co E, 334 Armd Regt, had been withdrawn to Hankay and bags were at work clearing the road block. Co G, 330th Inf, remained in the vicinity of Croix St Jacques. The 3d Bn, 36th AIR, closed in assembly area under CO R at 1430 hrs, at Bergifaz. At 1640 hrs the GP moved to Bn.

The 2d Bn was located 1000 yds north of Bagnes. Co E and Co F attacked through the woods there. Co D left Bagnes and moved into Lierneux where it joined Co E and Co F on road dead south of Lierneux. The 3d Bn was relieved from front line and moved to Barmont. At 1145 hrs, it was reported that Lt Col Fowler, CO, 3d Bn, 36th AIR, had been wounded by a mine explosion and that Maj Cheney was in command.

7 January 1945. The engineers worked under cover of darkness, and by 0200 hrs had cleared the block at 563862. At this time, Co G, 334 Armd Regt and 1 platoon Co C, 330th Inf, moved down the main road to contact Cos A and B, 330th Inf. Movement was slow since the engineers were sweeping the road ahead of the tanks. At 0927 hrs, contact had been made between the Infantry and the tanks. The force continued moving and at 1127 hrs was on the objective (CR 576832). At 1225 hrs, the roads running north, east and west from the objective, were reported blocked. At 1600 hrs, information was received that the 1st Bn, 330th Inf, would be relieved by the 1st Bn, 333d Inf, at daylight, 8 January. The period closed with plans being perfected for the relief.

Co E, 2d Bn, 36th AIR, with tanks of 1st Bn, 334, assaulted Bagnes and Co D and Co F seized high ground southeast of Bagnes. 3d Bn was located in Barmont conducting rehabilitation and reorganization of companies.

8 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night and at 0800 hrs the relief of the 1st Bn, 330th Inf, by the 1st Bn, 333d Inf, was reported to be progressing satisfactorily and at 0830 hrs, the relief was reported complete. Contact was made with CO B, on CO R's left, at 0910 hrs. At 1546 hrs, orders were issued to have 1st Bn, 333d Inf, in conjunction with 2d Bn, 333d Inf, on right, push to the edge of the woods at 5783 and establish road block at 577837 and 586842. At 1805 hrs, the 1st Bn, 333d Inf, had established road blocks at 577837 and 586842, and had pushed to the edge of the woods at 578832 to get a better field of fire. Tanks from Hogan's force were moved to reinforce the block. Contact was maintained on the left but no contact was established on the right, at the close of the period.

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The towns of Hebreval and Ottre were 2d Bn objectives. Co D seized Hebreval and Co E seized the high ground south of Hebreval. Co F advanced down the road to Ottre and was held up by small arms fire. 1st Bn, 334, assaulted Ottre and Co D and Co E outposted the town. There was no change in the situation of the 2d Bn.

9 January 1945. During the night contact was maintained on the left. However, due to inclement weather which had disrupted communications, information concerning contact did not reach the 2d Bn, 334 Inf (Co E, 2d AB) until morning. At 0615 hrs, information was given to Col Hogan that he would be relieved of the responsibility of the cross-roads by the CO, 1st Bn, 334 Inf. The relief depended on the arrival of the tanks and TDs that normally support the 334 Inf. After relief, Hogan would assemble in Regne. At 1405 hrs, the responsibility of the cross-roads passed to the CO, 1st Bn, 334 Inf, and Hogan commenced movement to Regne where he closed at 1730 hrs. Upon reaching Regne, Hogan was given the mission of setting up road blocks to protect the right flank of the 83d Division. Contact was established on the right and left and all remained quiet until the close of the period.

The 1st Bn was relieved from attached to CO R and was attached to CO A, as part of TF I. Co D and Co E, 36th AIR were in assembly area in Ottre. Co F was located on the high ground south of Hebreval. The 3d Bn, 36th AIR moved to Lierneux and was attached to CO R.

10 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night and contact patrols continued without interruption. At 1000 hrs, the Adv GP moved from Bra to 628897, near La Vaux. 1 Platoon Co I, 36th AIR, was sent to Regne for infantry security at the road blocks and arrived there at 1415 hrs. TF K-ne, (1st Bn, 32d Armd Regt and 3d Bn, 36th AIR) moved to vicinity of Verlemont and closed at 1520 hrs. At 1905 hrs, information was received that 1st Bn, 330th Inf, had taken Bihain and would now revert to CO R. At 2326 hrs, Col Hogan was ordered to relieve attached tanks and TDs of the 330th Inf in Bihain on the morning of 11 January.

The 1st Bn occupied and improved defensive positions at Proveroux and Co B was attached to TF Miller. Co D and Co E, 36th AIR, were located in Ottre with Co F on the high ground south of Hebreval.

11 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night and Hogan's tanks relieved 1st Bn, 330th Inf tanks at 0645 hrs and at 0640 hrs, had repulsed a small counter-attack of tanks and infantry, that approached Bihain from the south. One enemy tank was destroyed. At 1330 hrs, 1 platoon of TDs was detached from Lane and attached to the 83d Recon Bn. At 1330 hrs, the 1st Bn, 330th Inf and Co H, 33d Armd Regt, under Hogan's command, was ordered to attack south from Bihain, with the bridge at 626823 as the objective. The 83d Recon Bn was to take over the position in Bihain. The attack jumped off at 1600 hrs and at 1630 hrs, they were reported 1000 yds south of Bihain,

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encountering no opposition. At 1755 hrs, it was reported that Hogan's tanks were held up by a road block at 626826 and that the infantry had proceeded ahead. The block consisted of knocked out enemy vehicles. The infantry was reported on the objective at 1900 hrs. The tanks were in the process of clearing the block previously mentioned. The force was ordered to secure itself for the night. Later it was found that the infantry had withdrawn 200 yds to the north to provide security for the tanks. The entire force was reported secure along the edge of the woods at 626823, at 2140 hrs. Hogan reported that the infantry had been badly depleted due to exposure and frost bite and that they could not put up a strong defense. Co A of the 83d Regt, now located in Bihain, was alerted to move to the assistance of Hogan in the event of a counter-attack. 1 Plat Co C, 33d Armd Regt, went to Fraiture to hold the positions vacated by the 83d Regt and conducted patrols from Regne to the cross-roads at 575852.

The 1st Bn was on defense at Provedroux. Co D and Co E, 36th AIR remained in Ottre with Co F on the high ground south of Hebreval.

12 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night and it was unnecessary to call upon the Co of the 83d Regt that had been alerted for use. At 0955 hrs, the 83d Regt passed through Hogan's position and continued the attack to the south. Contact was maintained with the rear of the 83d Regt by means of light tanks from Hogan's force. Hogan was ordered to move at 1050 hrs with the remainder of his force, which was in Regne-Fraiture area, to Bihain and Kane was ordered to move to the Regne-Fraiture area from Verlemeant. At 1215 hrs, both forces were reported to be moving and both had closed in their respective areas prior to dark. Adv GP moved to Hebreval at 1800 hrs. At 1400 hrs, the 2d Plat Co G, 33d Armd Regt and 3d Plat Co I, 36th AIR, set out from Bihain to contact the 2d Armd Div at Pissarrote. This force encountered resistance in the woods southwest of Bihain and on high ground at 617830. Pissarrote was found to be occupied by the enemy and the force soiled for the night at 609824. About 1800 hrs, 1 Co infantry, 1 section tank destroyers, 1 section medium tanks, and 1 platoon light tanks, all from Hogan's force, established road blocks at 619816 and 625813. The 83d Regt came under CG R's control at 1635 hrs. At 2315 hrs, PG No 2, CG R (confirming verbal orders) was issued for the attack of the Combat Command at 0800 hrs, 13 January. The Combat Command would attack with 2d Yeomans and 2d Kane abreast. Kane, on the left, will capture Mont-le-Bon initially, then proceed south to capture road junction at 638762, then capture Vaux. Yeomans, on the right, would capture high ground at 645763 then continue the attack to capture Sonneraine. Hogan, in reserve, would be prepared to move to the assistance of either Kane or Yeomans, protect rear of the Combat Command and maintain contact with 2d Armd Div on the right.

The 1st Bn was located in Burt and Grand Burt, after being relieved on position at Provedroux, by 1st Bn, 289th Inf, 79th Div. Co D and Co E, 36th AIR, moved to assembly area at Petite Langlir and Co F moved to Ottre.

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13 January 1945. Yeomans' forward elements were reported at 030700 at the opening of the period. Kane's movement from the Regne-Fraiture area began at 0500 hrs and at 0927 hrs had pushed out ahead of the position occupied by the 83d Rec Bn, which had sidestepped to the right and went into the attack for the high ground at 025701. At 1100 hrs, Kane was reported on the edge of Mont-le-Ban and was receiving very stiff opposition from enemy tanks, artillery and mortars. At 1240 hrs, Yeomans' force was in the woods at 634766 and was continuing the attack on Semerain. The high ground at 025701 was avoided by Yeomans, due to lack of cover. However, a section was put on the high ground to hold it. At 1440 hrs, TF Kane was still on the edge of Mont-le-Ban and was still receiving stiff opposition. At 1700 hrs, Kane was ordered to leave a containing force at Mont-le-Ban and by-pass the town to the right and at 1750 hrs, was reported to be at 638700. The 83d Rec Bn attacked at 1415 hrs to capture Semerain, but was driven back due to high losses. At 1800 hrs, the 83d Rec Bn was ordered to push a force down to the road junction at 639701 and block the road. A force from TF Kane, under command of Maj Cheneay, was ordered to push down the road leading to the northeast from 639701 and to tie in with the 83d Rec Bn there. Information was received at 1928 hrs that CO A would take over Hogan's mission in Bihain. Hogan was ordered to move his force, at 0600 hrs, 14 Jan, to the outskirts of Mont-le-Ban; take command of Kane's containing force; and capture the town. At 2015 hrs, information was received that Kane had contacted Yeomans' force 400 yds north of the road junction at 639701 and it was found that the road was not physically blocked. The 83d Rec Bn was ordered to block the road physically and the block was reported in place at 2355 hrs. Yeomans was ordered to take over the force of Kane, that had joined him and attack east on the morning of 14 Jan and to capture Vaux. He was to leave a force on the road block at 639701.

Co A and Co C, 36th AIR, moved to the Regne-Bihain area and Co C, in Bihain, was attached to TF Miller and was occupying road blocks. Co A was in Hebreval. At 1500 hrs, Co F, 36th AIR, moved forward from Ottre and Langlir with Co E, 36th AIR, and Co D, 36th AIR, following and was held up south of Langlir. Cos D and E, 36th AIR, secured the high ground overlooking Bihain. Co F overcame the resistance and secured the bridgehead on the stream north of Bihain.

14 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night. At 0825 hrs, Kane was reported to have elements on the west edge of Mont-le-Ban and that they believed the town was still strongly held. At 0827 hrs, the report was received that Hogan was moving down to join Kane. At 0905 hrs, the Adv CP moved to Bihain. The plan for Kane's and Hogan's attack on Mont-le-Ban was as follows: Kane to attack from the northwest; Hogan from the west; time of attack 1200 hrs. At 1040 hrs, Yeomans jumped off in his attack to capture Vaux and after an advance of 800 yds, he was forced to withdraw to his original position due to heavy anti-tank fire. The attack on Mont-le-Ban started at 1215 hrs and at 1315 hrs, elements were reported in the town.

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Yeomans was ordered to remain in his present position. At 1525 hrs, the town of Mont-le-Bon was reported to be secure and at 1540 hrs, information was received that 2P Miller, of CG A, would take over the positions Mont-le-Bon. 2P Kane was detached from Hagan and was ordered to assemble southwest of Mont-le-Bon. Hagan was ordered to initiate an attack on Vaux. Yeomans' mission was to hold the road block at 639761 and woods on high ground at 635760. At 1730 hrs, one Co medium tanks and one Co infantry was detached from Kane and attached to Yeomans. Yeomans was detached from CG R, at this time, and attached to Division, operating under their control. At 1755 hrs, Hagan's attack on Vaux was pinned down by concentrated anti-tank fire and heavy artillery. The period closed with Hagan reorganizing for another attack on Vaux.

The 1st Bn, 36th AIR, moved to Boclain and established road blocks after the capture of the town by CG D. Battle group consisted of 1st Bn, 36th AIR (- Co C) and Co E, 334 Arm'd Regt. The 2d Bn, 36th AIR, captured Boclain late in the afternoon. Cos D and F assaulted the town and Co I secured the town with the 1st Bn, 334 Arm'd Regt, until relieved by CG A.

15 January 1945. At 0100 hrs, 2P Miller relieved elements of Kane in Mont-le-Bon and at 0135 hrs, Hagan was reported to have his leading elements at 640774. However, at 0215 hrs, he was stopped by enemy tank fire and was unable to leave a defiladed position. At 0600 hrs, Hagan reported that he had reached a point 100 yds from the main road and had lost 25% of his infantry. He withdrew to a point just south of Malouroux and recommended that if the attack was to be continued, that it be coordinated with another force. At 0600 hrs, the following plan was formulated - Hagan to attack from present positions and capture high ground (640772; then capture Vaux. Kane to move, via cross-roads after Hagan had cleared Malouroux, to capture Brisy. Time of Hagan's attack was set at 0930 hrs. There was a delay and at 1000 hrs, Hagan's attack jumped off and Kane's was reported in progress at 1115 hrs. At 1205 hrs, Hagan's leading elements were reported on the southwest edge of the initial objective, receiving heavy anti-tank fire from the left. At 1540 hrs, the Adv CP moved to Mont-le-Bon. At 1615 hrs, Kane's leading elements were reported at 644758. Hagan was reported to be in Vaux at 1700 hrs and Kane was ordered to secure himself on his present position. At 2245 hrs, Hagan was told to be prepared to attack Cheraim the following day. The following plan was formulated for 16 Jan 1945 - Hagan to push off to Cheraim, Kane to continue attack on Brisy, after neutralization of Hill 662755 by smoke. Time of attack was 0830 hrs.

The 1st Bn, 36th AIR, was on road blocks in the Boclain area. Cos D and E, 36th AIR, moved out at 1100 hrs and moved into the western edge of Steppigny. Co F, 36th AIR, was located east of Boclain and was held up by direct tank fire.

16 January 1945. Attempts were made during the night to coordinate Hagan's attack on Cheraim with the right column of CG D. However, help from that flank was not forthcoming. At 0630 hrs, Kane commenced his attack on Brisy. At 0800 hrs, Hagan reported

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that he had infantry across the bridge at 0617Z and were moving into the town of Cheraim with little opposition. The bridge, above mentioned, had been blown and prevented the passage of Hogan's armor. However, information was received at 0900 hrs that Hogan's infantry was on the objective and that armor from CGD was being sent into town from the north. Col Hogan was ordered to start movement of his force in the direction of Brisy in support of Kano's forces. At 1000 hrs, Kano was reported to have pushed 500 yds south and was still receiving anti-tank fire from enemy guns on his left flank. Information was received at 1005 hrs, that Hogan's infantry would be relieved in Cheraim, upon the arrival of TF Bailey, CG D. Hogan was to continue his attack south to relieve the pressure on Kano. At 1117 hrs, Kano was reported to be stopped by an anti-tank ditch at 0527Z and Hogan's attack south had gone 200 yds from Vaux and had inflicted heavy losses on enemy infantry and had knocked out two tanks. The Co of infantry and the Co of tanks, with Locans, were relieved and reverted to CG R at 1215 hrs and were attached to Kano. At 1330 hrs, Hogan's force had contacted elements of CG R in Cheraim and had turned over the defense of the town to them. At 1403 hrs, Kano had lost one tank to enemy tank fire and had been given air support. At 1420 hrs, he had withdrawn to a defiladed position at 0407Z. At 1449 hrs, Col Hogan was evacuated due to illness. Maj Brown assumed command of the 3d Bn, 33d Armd Regt. Both forces had suffered heavy casualties in both infantry and tanks and were ordered to discontinue the attack and prepare for a night attack. At 1724 hrs, orders were received from Div to secure the forces in position. Contact on right and left was established and both forces pushed patrols towards Brisy. Composition of troops at this time - TF Hogan - 3d Bn, 33d Armd Regt; 1st Bn 330th Inf; Co I, 36th AIR; 1 plat Co C, 23d Engrs and 1 plat Co G, 7034 TD Bn — TF Kano - 1st Bn, 32d Armd Regt; 3d Bn, 36th AIR (- Co I); 1 plat Co C, 23d Engrs; and 1 plat Co G, 7034 TD Bn.

Cos D and E, 36th AIR, remained in Sterpigny. During the night, Co F, 36th AIR, moved from Baelain area and into Cheraim and secured the town. Cos D and E, 36th AIR, were relieved in Sterpigny and moved to Cheraim.

17 January 1945. At 0520 hrs the patrol from Kano's force returned and reported that they had observed enemy infantry digging in along the 75 grid line and had located 2 enemy tanks with infantry at 0447Z. At 0810 hrs, information was received that CG R would be relieved by the 4th Cav Group. Brown (3d 33d) was informed that he would take over CG A's road blocks in the Halouzeaux area and Kano was told that he would take over road blocks in Mont-le-Ban. At 1330 hrs, the 1st Bn, 330th Inf, was ordered to relieve 1st Bn, 36th AIR, on roadblocks in Baelain area and movement from Vaux by this unit commenced at 1530 hrs. At 1711 hrs, the 1st Bn, 330th Inf had closed in the Baelain area and at 1935 hrs, the relief was reported complete. Plans continued throughout the afternoon for Kano's and Brown's relief by the 4th Cav Group, the following day. Maj Brown was instructed to send

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19 January 1945. At 0215 hrs, Co L, 335th Inf, was on its objective (woods - 663702) and had established the bridgehead. The engineers started work on the bridge (664704) at 0230 hrs and completed work at 0400 hrs. At 0600 hrs, the 2d Bn, 335th Inf, began movement to 663702 and at 0700 hrs, had joined Co L. 1st Bn, 334 Armd Regt, began movement to join the Inf Bn at 0800 hrs. At 0900 hrs, the attack started with Cos I and K, 335th Inf, leading, supported by the tanks of the 1st Bn, 334 Armd Regt and heavy weapons of Co M, 335th Inf. Co L, 335th Inf, remained in the woods (663702). At 0930 hrs, the leading elements (Co K, 335th Inf) were reported at 663702 and were advancing with no resistance. The advance continued without opposition and at 1000 hrs, Co L, 335th Inf, was reported on the objective (660747), where they met slight resistance. Co I, 335th Inf, supported by some of Kane's tanks, continued toward Brisy and at 1200 hrs, was moving into the town with slight resistance. Co L, 335th Inf, had moved to the objective at 660747 to join Co K, 335th Inf. At 1200 hrs, the objective was reported secure and concertina wire was requested. Contact for the night was arranged with CO B, on the left, and the 4th Cav Sqd on the right. At 1930 hrs, Col Kane reported that he had sent a patrol to determine the route of withdrawal of the enemy from Brisy. They had returned and reported the bridge at 650759 was intact but was prepared for demolition.

The 1st Bn, 36th AIR, moved to Steppigny-Bengies area. Co D (- 1 platoon) captured high ground today at 084755 without opposition. The remainder of the Bn moved to an assembly area at 085752 and attacked TF I's objective, which was captured without opposition. Co D and Co E, 36th AIR, were relieved and moved back into Gherain.

20 January 1945. All remained quiet throughout the night. Contact was maintained with CO A, on the left, but patrols from Kane's force failed to make contact with elements of the 4th Cav Sqd, on the right. At 0830 hrs, Operations Memorandum No 23, 34 Armd Div, was received. This memorandum directed that CO R would be relieved by the 4th Cav Sqd on 20 Jan and would assemble in the Baulain-Bihain area. At 0930 hrs, a meeting was held at the Regt CP and plans were completed for the relief. At 1305 hrs, the relief of Kane's force, by the 4th Cav Sqd, was reported complete and the CO, 4th Cav Sqd assumed responsibility for the zone. The 3d Bn, 335th Inf, reverted to the control of the 335th Inf Regt at 1330 hrs. Plans were made for a move to a rest area in Somme Leuze, Belgium, on Jan 21 and at 1930 hrs the route of march for the move was received from Div. At 2040 hrs, Kane's force closed in the Bihain area and at 2140 hrs, permission was granted to relieve Brown's force from the road blocks in the Baulain area, 0800 21 Jan.

The 1st Bn, 36th AIR, began relief of 1st Bn, 335th Inf Regt and elements of 2d Bn, 334 Armd Regt. Relief was completed at 1630 hrs. The 2d Bn, 36th AIR, was in Gherain, resting and doing rehabilitation.

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21 January 1945. Combat Command commenced movement to west area at Soum Leuze, Belgium, at 1109 hrs. At 1715 hrs, the 1st Bn, 36th Armd Regt, closed into area 333939 and at 1850 hrs the 3d Bn, 36th Armd Regt and the 2d Bn, 36th AIR closed in the Soum Leuze area. CP now located at 348963. Movement of Combat Command was reported complete at 2115 hrs.

The 2d Bn, 36th AIR, moved with CO B to Heus and remained there through 31 January, conducting training, rehabilitation, maintenance and rest. The 1st Bn, 36th AIR was relieved by the 3d Bn, 355th Inf Regt at 1630 hrs and moved to Oppagne where they remained through 31 January, conducting rehabilitation, training maintenance and rest.

22 January 1945. The Regimental CP moved to a more suitable location at 1442 hrs and arrived at the new CP location (333952), at 1450 hrs. Combat Command conducted rest, rehabilitation and maintenance.

23 January 1945. At 1430 hrs, a meeting of unit commanders of the Combat Command was held at the CP and administrative details were discussed. Colonel Hause departed to join party at Division HQs for trip to London, at 2350 hrs. Lt Col Carlton P. Russell, designated by Commanding General, Third Armored Division, to command Combat Command "R", in the absence of Colonel Hause. Lt Col T J Moran assumed command of the 36th Armored Infantry Regiment.

24 January 1945 - 31 January 1945. Combat Command "R" remained in rest area in the vicinity of Soum Leuze, Belgium and conducted training, rehabilitation and maintenance from 24 January through 31 January 1945. The training consisted of firing, orientation of new men, tank-infantry cooperation and familiarization with enemy mines and booby traps.

Changes in Command:

Capt Smith took over command of 2d Bn, 36th Armd Inf Regt, upon the evacuation of Maj T G Tousay on 4 Jan 1945. Capt G E Smith commanded the 2d Bn, 36th Armd Inf Regt, until he was wounded in action on 5 Jan 1945. Capt J H Metcalfe took over command from Capt G E Smith and commanded the Bn until Lt Col T J Moran joined and assumed command on 18 Jan 1945. Col Moran commanded the Bn from 18 Jan throughout the remainder of the period.

Maj R E Cheneay took over command of the 3d Bn, 36th Armd Inf Regt when Lt Col W L Fowler was wounded and evacuated on 6 Jan.

No other changes in command.

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S A Q R E X

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a patrol of four men down the creek toward Brizy to determine the nature of the bridge at 664764 and Lane was ordered to send a patrol into Brizy. Brown was also informed that the 3d Bn, 36th AIB, would be attached to him and that he would take over Boelain, Halouroux and Mont-le-Bon areas. Lane was to attack Brizy with a Bn of Infantry, to be attached. At 2026 hrs, 1st Bn, 330th Infantry was released to the control of CO A.

The 2nd Bn, 36th AIB was outposting the town of Cheraign.

18 January 1945. Information was received from C-3, at 0020 hrs that the 3d Bn, 335th Infantry, would join CO R about 1100 hrs. At 0625 hrs, the patrol from Lane's force that had the mission of going to Brizy, returned and reported that they had encountered dug in Infantry on the edges of the town and were unable to enter the town. Brown's patrol returned and reported that the stream was fordable only 200 yds south of Vaux. The 4th Cav Squadron began relieving Lane at 0930 hrs. At 1030 hrs, Brown was instructed to send a patrol in command of an officer to the woods south of Cheraign, to get a report on the bridge at 664764. Lane's relief was reported complete at 1241 hrs and at 1440 hrs the relief of Brown, in Vaux, by the 4th Cav was reported complete. At 1545 hrs, Brown had taken over the road blocks in the Boelain area and Lane had assembled in Mont-le-Bon. The 3d Bn, 335th had joined Lane by this time. At 1600 hrs, one company of the 3d Bn, 335th was ordered to move at once to Cheraign and report to Col Welborn. This company was to be used to extricate a patrol that had become cut off in Bettigny. However, after the arrival of the company in Cheraign, it was found that its employment wasn't necessary and it reverted to CO R control. It was decided that the company would remain in Cheraign. Brown's patrol returned at 1820 hrs and reported the bridge intact but unsuitable for tanks, also woods at 663761 were heavily trapped. At 1905 hrs, the CO decided to move Co L, 335th Infantry (company in Cheraign) south from Cheraign to woods at 663761 to clear out woods and cover the engineers in the construction of a treadway bridge at 664764. The remainder of the 3d Bn, 335th, was ordered to these woods at 0600 hrs, 19 January and Lane to move there at 0800 hrs, on the same day. Upon arrival of Lane at this point, the 3d Bn, 335th, would be attached to him. If Lane, with 3d Bn, 335th, was ordered to attack at 0900 hrs on 19 January, to capture high ground at 660746 and Brizy. At 2230 hrs, Co L, 335th, started movement south from Cheraign and at 2330 hrs, was reported at 663764.

From 16 January to 18 January, the 1st Bn, 36th AIB remained in Boelain and occupied road blocks with Co A and Co B, 36th AIB, relieved by 1st Bn, 330th Infantry, on the night of 17 January. Lane was made to Bettigny and Sterpigny on 18 January, in preparation for TF I attack. Co P and Co Z, 36th AIB with 1st Bn, 330th, attacked high ground and secured the south part of Cheraign. Col Moran joined and assumed command of the 3d Bn, 36th AIB.
